For his first participation in one of the Roadsign Continental Challenge events, **the Romanian Julian Rotariu won THE TRACK in 57h06'20"** and he also set a new record on the competition. His compatriot **Andrei Gligor** finished second in 59h02'35". Winner of 3 stages whose the long stage of 137 km, the Belgian **Guy Goossens** takes a great third place.

In the women's category, **Leigh Hawkes** finished 11th overall and first woman in 78h33'48". The women's podium is completed by Australia's **Heather Hawkins** and German **Andrea Löw** respectively second and third.
