THE TRACK Outback Race will take place in an authentic region with a fragrance of adventure.

Participants will start from the **West MacDonnell National Park** for two technical stages. Then they will take the South way, will cross Aboriginal Lands to join the **Finke Gorge National Park**.

On the second part of the itinerary, they will go at the **Mt Conner** then at **Uluru**, the iconic place in Australia.

THE TRACK is the longest self-supported endurance foot race in the world. This competition in the Australian Outback is a great challenge. Competitors must exceed their limits to do it.

- 17 May - Stage 1 : **Ellery Creek – Serpentine Chalet Dam** [30 km – 700 mD+]
- 18 May - Stage 2 : **Serpentine Chalet Dam – Finke River Camp** [41 km – 1000 mD+]
- 19 May - Stage 3 : **Finke River Camp – Hermannsburg** [41 km]
- 20 May - Stage 4 : **Hermannsburg – Boggy Hole** [48,5 km]
- 21 May - Stage 5 : **Boggy Hole – Palmer River** [59 km]
- 22 May – Stage 6 : **Palmer River – Ernest Road** [58 km]
- 23 May - Stage 7 : **Ernest Road – Angas Downs** [64 km]
- 24 May - Stage 8 : **Angas Downs – Mont Conner** [53 km]
- 25 & 26 May - Stage 9 : **Mont Conner – Uluru** [127,5 km – 2 days]
